Little Shuswap Lake Indian Band (LSLIB) Volunteer Fire Department

The LSLIB First Nation Chief and Council are accepting applications for the position of Volunteer Fire Chief. The LSLIB Volunteer Fire Department serves the residents of LSLIB First Nation Indian Reserves 1 (Quaaout), 2 (Chum Creek) and 4 (Scotch Creek).

Competencies Required Included:

Knowledge of and ability to apply modern administration and management techniques for fire suppression including organization, staffing, financing, budgeting, equipment management and maintenance, as well as short and long-range operational planning.

Desired Minimum Qualifications:

Training and experience in firefighting and the management of firefighting personnel and equipment. Advanced training in first aid and emergency response procedures preferred, but not required. Willingness and ability to obtain training in emergency medical services and/or fire fighting. Any combination of education and experience which provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities to perform the essential functions of this job. Necessary Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: thorough knowledge of fire suppression and prevention and emergency medical services principles, procedures, techniques, and equipment. Working knowledge of first aid and resuscitation techniques and their application as demonstrated through training leading to certification. Note: LSLIB will work with the Volunteer Fire Chief to obtain funding for training and equipment in support of the Fire Chief and Volunteer Fire Department members.

Compensation: This is negotiable, based on qualifications and available funding.
