Position Summary

The Land Manager is responsible for providing support and strategic direction for the management of Indian Reserve lands and associated resources, and in representing the interests of the Little Shuswap Lake Indian Band in land management decision-making processes, developing land and natural resource policies and plans, and provide support in the implementation of various land management agreements. The Manager will play a key role in the effective management of LSLIB reserve lands and other types of land owned by LSLIB (e.g. fee simple) and providing advisory support for managing territorial lands and resources.

The management position is responsible for:

- Providing program direction and implementation of short and long term strategies;
- Developing annual plans and budgets;
- Participating in negotiations and managing departmental staff;
- Reporting to the Executive Director, Territorial Resource Stewardship directly;
- Engaging in strategic and operational planning for LSLIB lands management;
